

Pre + K TALKING TIPS: Who Likes Books?

Guest speaker and teacher—review this document together prior to the classroom visit.

Introduce the guest in a simple manner. Their name and primary role in the community.

Guest: *“Hello! Today I’m here to talk about books and reading. . .”*

Q. Who likes books? Ask for raised hands before calling on a student.

Discuss what kinds of books the students enjoy.

Q. When do you read? Look for raised hands.

Q. Who reads to you? Look for raised hands.

Let’s read a story together. This is a book that you get to take home with you.

Pass out copies of the book and explain to the students that you will show them when it’s time to turn each page.

Q. What did you like about this story? Look for raised hands.

Tell the students that they will also complete a coloring page from the book (print earlier from the Classroom Visits page at AlaskanOwned.com).

Let the students know that it was very nice to meet them before you go.

The teacher asks for volunteers to send finished coloring pages to display at the speaker’s place of business.
